O'er the land of the free and the home of the brave?




Dingle Dangle Scarecrow

won't you guide my sleigh tonight?"



(Hop up and down.)






Friendship







She makes me cookies and yummy treats.





The Dolphin Song



Baby shark doo doo, doo doo de doo...


{small hand motion opening and closing like a mouth}

{knuckles hand motion opening and closing like a mouth with no teeth}


