#### Pip the Pup Back to School Scavenger Hunt | Overview

Thanks so much for downloading the Pip the Pup Back to School Scavenger Hunt packet! This packet is designed to offer an engaging way for students to explore their new school with the help of Pip the Pup. Pick and choose from the included school location cards. Discard the cards that do not apply to your students or school. Prior to the scavenger hunt, place the cards around the school. Think ahead about the order which you will navigate around the school. You can choose to write that down on a post-it note. Begin the scavenger hunt by reading the "Oh, Pip" card. Travel around the school while reading each clue. Take time in each location to get students acquainted with the school staff, rules for that area, and/or things found in that area.

End the scavenger hunt by returning to your classroom. Students will then find an additional note from Pip the Pup. You can choose one of the two ending versions. You can leave a possible surprise for the students including: a snack, the including coloring sheet, and/or another surprise of choice.



Pip the Pup also likes to play games. Pip likes basketball, tag, jump roping, and sit-ups, too. Where would Pip the Pup go in the school to play games?




Sometimes Pip the Pup eats too much or plays too hard and feels sick. Where might Pip the Pup go if Pip feels sick?





Pip the Pup also likes quiet time with books. Maybe Pip the Pup is napping in this quiet spot. Where should we go check?



Sometimes Pip likes to study fancy art projects, too. Where could Pip the Pup be?





# Pip, Pip, Hooray!


Oh, no! We were not quick enough and Pip the Pup already left, but look what Pip left us! Thank you so much, Pip the Pup!

amazing day. Woof, Woof!






